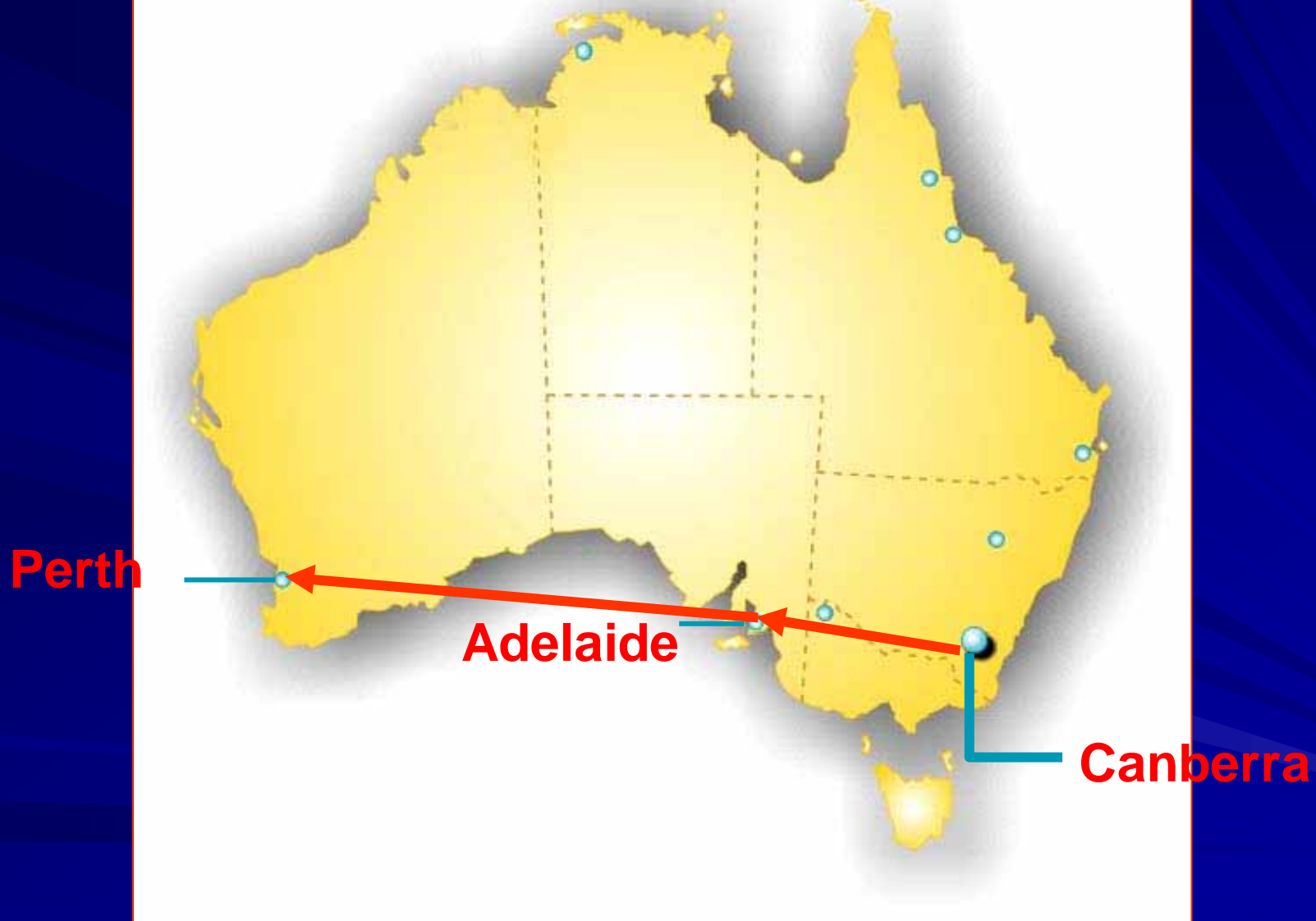

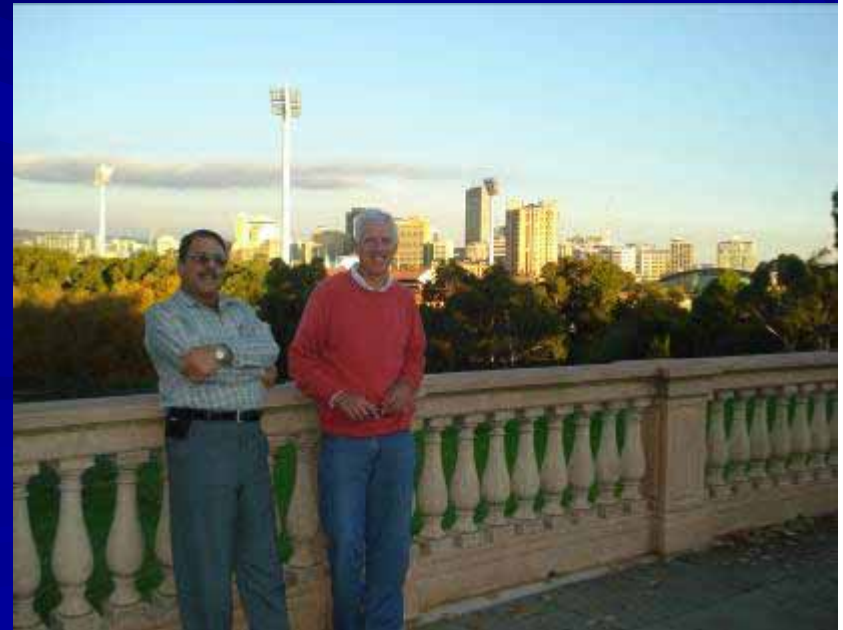

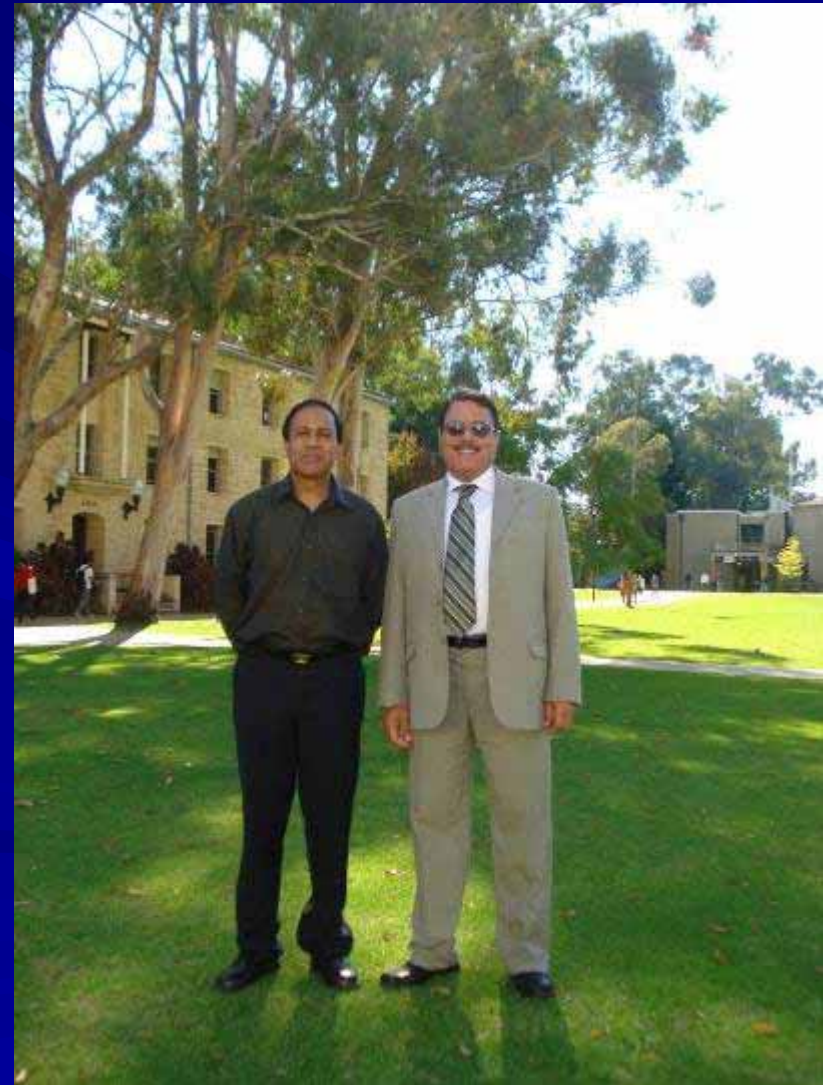

Dr Bader is keen to understand how to construct zero till trial machinery, to help rebuild Iraq's agricultural research capacity and WANTFA has offered assistance to do this.

Hafiz Mujeeb from the Pakistan Government also met with the WANTFA team in May and will be looking closely at WANTFA's extension processes to see if they can be applied in six model no-till sites in Pakistan.
